› Copenhagen, Denmark

- Consistently rated as a top education system in the world, Denmark integrates social topics into key parts of their curriculum to emphasize their goal of informing global citizens. Their well-known “hygge” philosophy is woven throughout curriculum and classroom.

- Poland's post-Communist education reform in the 1990s paved the way for systemic progress and innovation. The system places a large emphasis on teacher education and youth development in and out of the classroom, which continues to drive Polish education forward.

› Reggio Emilia, Italy

Like the name suggest, Reggio Emilia is the birthplace of the progressive Reggio Emilia approach seen most commonly in Early Education. This approach highlights the creative and student-centered learning and has spread regionally throughout Italy and around the world.

› **Panama City, Panama**

- Panama has seen an overall improvement to their education system, despite longstanding issues with quality. With a booming economy, Panama relies on quality education and training to maintain a skilled workforce, providing an insightful look into reforms and growth in the sector.

- Despite a growing economy, Peru's education system lags in development. Students will learn about the disparity in education and structural indicators impeding reform, as well as the national system and local offerings in Lima specifically.
